### **Suggested Activities**

**I.** Create a timeline of Cornelia's life. This can be done individually or in small groups. Compare timelines.

**II.** Make a list of the names of people mentioned in her story. Identify each person and the connection each had with Cornelia.

**IV.** Stop to discuss the meaning of each of the quotes by Cornelia Connelly included in the FlipBook.

- What does each quote say about Cornelia?
- What does each quote mean for you today as a member of a Holy Child school?

**V.** This activity might work better for students who are not new to a Holy Child school but perhaps are in their final year.

- Read each of the quotes (not Cornelia's) that are included throughout the FlipBook.
- What kind of impact has Cornelia had on each person?
- Imagine that you have been asked to write a comment for this FlipBook as a student who is soon to graduate. Write your comment and share with the class.
