

PARTNER FOOTLOOSE GAME

Students can review *Coloring Cornelia* before playing game.

Materials needed: Footloose questions, answers and answer sheet chart for 20 questions.

Goal: To correctly answer as many questions as possible before the end of the game

DIRECTIONS

1. This is a partner game.
2. Each player receives a blank answer sheet chart.
3. Make up 20 numbered cards with questions so that each card corresponds to a numbered answer. Put the number on both the front and the back of each card.
4. Arrange the desks in groups of two.
5. Put one question card on each desk and in various other spots of the room. Extra cards can be put on empty tables, the floor, window sill, or out in the hallway. *In the original Footloose game, all questions are put in one location and each group would get one question, answer it, then go get another, etc.
6. To start the game each group can go to any area. At the signal, the students turn over their card, read it, answer it, and write the appropriate answer in the same numbered square on their answer sheet.
7. When finished each problem, each pair of students may go to any area where there are cards and figure out the next answer. Repeat.
 - The game progresses until time is called. The length of the game is up to the teacher's discretion.
 - Any student or pair of students behaving inappropriately receives a 20 second time-out in a designated penalty box.
 - After time is called each student returns to his/ her seat and uses a red pencil to correct his/her paper. A red "X" is put in any empty square and then the teacher reviews the answer to each question.
 - The winner is the group with the most squares filled in correctly.
