



Cornelia will have known these girls at St Leonards in the 1870's.

*The photo can be dated to 1875/6, as the last of the group to arrive at the school came in 1875 and the first to leave departed in 1876. The back of the photo reveals that they were **Enfants des Anges**. Fortunately the girls' names are written underneath the photo as follows:*

Back row, standing

Dorothea King b.1862, entered school 1875 (aged 13), left 1878.

Eleanor Roche b.1861, entered school 1871 (just before 10th b'day), leaving date not given.

Lucy Walton b. 1862, entered school 1872 (aged 10), no leaving date.

Front row, sitting or kneeling

Josephine Bacchus b. 1861, entered school 1871 (aged 10), no leaving date.

Eleanora Bethell b. 1863, entered school 1875 (aged 12), left 1879.

Edith no surname: [possibly someone's little sister?]

R D'Arcy : the only D'Arcy to fit the dates is actually Emma D'Arcy b.1864,
entered school 1873 (aged 9), left 1876.

Kattie Talbot b.1860, entered school 1873 (aged 13), left 1877.

To be discovered: what is Emma D'Arcy demonstrating? some kind of magnifier?
